

July 7th, 2020 – First Confirmed COVID-19 Case at Grandville Jireh

This communication is to inform you that we have our first confirmed COVID-19 case at Grandville Jireh. This individual tested positive on July 1st (result was confirmed on July 3rd). This individual works in the shipping department and has not been in the Jireh plant since Wednesday, June 24th. Per my phone conversation with this individual yesterday, he had a scheduled vacation day on June 25th and was out in public on June 27th, where he unfortunately may have contracted COVID-19.

As part of our COVID-19 response plan, the following actions have been taken:

- We have reached out to all individuals who may have had close contact with this individual and asked them to monitor for COVID-19 symptoms
- Those who have been in close contact with this individual **48 hours prior to him being symptomatic**, which was on June 27th, have been asked to quarantine at home
- We have notified the Kent County Health Department of a confirmed COVID-19 case
- The Kent County Health Department did confirm that those who may have had close contact with this individual on June 24th are fine, but should monitor for symptoms
- All areas that this individual may have been to, including the bathrooms and breakroom, have been clean and sanitized
